21. Pinot Noir – 2015 Handley Cellars, Anderson Valley Aromas of Bing cherry pie, dried rose petal, and baking spices precede flavors of raspberry, sour plum and a nutmeg. The finish is long and lingering punctuated by bright acidity.	3.25	13.00	38.00
22. Pinot Noir – 2015 Lucienne ‘Smith Vineyard’, Santa Lucia Highlands An elegant, classic representation of Pinot Noir grown in Monterey County. Dark cherry, cinnamon and pomegranate aromas with chocolate, rhubarb and cola on the palate. 94 pts <i>Wine Enthusiast</i>	5.00	20.00	55.00
23. Barbera – 2015 Bella Grace Vineyards, Amador County Rich and ripe, this full-bodied wine offers lush black-plum aromas, a palate-coating texture, ripe but not sweet cherry and raisin flavors and a soft velvety mouthfeel. For a varietal known for its acidity, this wine is surprisingly soothing to sip.	3.75	15.00	42.00
24. Grenache – 2016, Restless Earth, Santa Barbara County With lovely aromatics full of cherry and dried herbs with tart red fruit flavors such as pomegranate, redcurrant. This light, ruby red wine has soft tannins, a lean acidity and a nice, long finish.	3.25	13.00	38.00
25. Merlot – 2014, Hill Family Estate, Napa County A complex nose full of aromas of sweet mocha and blackberry, balanced out with earthy notes of cedar and cinnamon. Flavors of ripe dark fruits such as raspberry and black cherry with a slight acidity and soft tannins.	3.75	15.00	42.00
26. Merlot – 2013, “Pépé” Y. Rousseau, Moon Mountain District, Sonoma Valley The nose is full with sugarplums, violet petals and a freshly opened pack of fig newtons. The flavors of strawberry rhubarb pie slip into blueberries dusted in fine black pepper.	6.25	25.00	85.00
27. Sangiovese – 2015, Benessere Vineyards, St. Helena, Napa A Tuscan varietal, not widely produced in California, is a lighter bodied wine with bright acidity. Notes of cranberry, cedar and sandalwood. Elegant, balanced flavors of cocoa, cherry and hints of tobacco.	4.00	16.00	44.00
28. Tempranillo– 2013, “¡Viva Yo!” Bodegas, Paso Robles 90% Tempranillo, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon . Featuring bold cherry and plum with hints of smoke and leather, layered with the spices you expect from Tempranillo. This vintage brought soft tannins and bright fruit to this Paso Robles favorite.	3.25	13.00	38.00
29. Malbec – 2015, Berryessa Gap, Yolo County Spicy dark fruit dominate this wine. Inky purple in color with aromas of blackberry, plum, cedar, dust and smoke jump out of the glass.	3.00	12.00	37.00
30. GSM – 2015, “Absent Minded Professor”, League of Rogues, Paso Robles Made from 17% Grenache, 52% Syrah, 17% Mouvèdre and 15% Albariño. This medium French style wine featuring California fruit, with characteristics of Bing Cherry, spice and mocha.	2.25	9.00	29.00
31. Red Blend – 2014, Calluna Cuvée, Chalk Hill, Sonoma County A traditional Bordeaux style blend consisting of 47% Merlot, 26% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cab Franc, 9% Malbec and 8% Petite Verdot. Red and black currant notes with distinct herbal notes of bay leaf. A medium bodied wine that has flavors of blackberry and a chewy texture with a lengthy finish.	4.50	18.00	49.00
32. Cabernet Franc – 2015, Carr Winery, Santa Ynez Valley This wine shows off an incredible balance between tannins and acid, with a nose full of green pepper, blueberry and chocolate. Rich flavors of black cherries and cassis.	3.75	15.00	42.00
33. Syrah – 2009, Saxon Brown, Sonoma Coast Wonderful violet, lavender and dark exotic fruits are showcased in this classic style Syrah from the Sonoma Coast. The palate leads to tart berry flavors and a dark chocolate finish.	3.50	14.00	40.00
34. Syrah – 2013, “The Octopod”, Furlong Estates, Alexander Valley This well-balanced Syrah offers aromas of dark berries and black current. A hint of spice, rich plum flavors and a pronounced tannin structure leads to a long, complex finish.	2.75	11.00	34.00
35. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2014, Dewitt Family, Alexander Valley This classic example of Cabernet Sauvignon will display hardy plum and strong oak notes, with a rich mouth feel, and an exceptionally long finish. Only 300 cases produced!	4.00	16.00	44.00

Cabernet Sauvignon – 2014, Silver Ghost, Napa Valley Named in honor of the winemakers’ great grandfather, who helped launch the Silver Ghost Rolls Royce, the pedigree of this classic Cabernet Sauvignon truly exceeds itself with lush texture and opulent tannins. Complex aromas of black cherry, smoked herbs and coffee on the nose lead to a rich mouthfeel, well-integrated tannins and velvet fruit flavors.	4.75	19.00	51.00
37. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2013, Y. Rousseau, Mt. Veeder, Napa Valley Fresh dark fruits dominate the nose, while earthy undertones, hints of leather, tobacco and cocoa powder add to the aromatic complexity. Named one of the top 100 wineries in the world in 2015!			95.00

Cabernet Sauvignon – 2010, “Stephanie”, Hestan Vineyards, Napa Valley Produced by award winning winemaker, Jeff Gaffner, this wine shows off fresh boysenberry and blueberry that develop into spice notes such as cinnamon and clove. Balanced by flavors of mocha and dark chocolate with an elegant finish from lingering sweet oak tannins.			110.00

Cabernet Sauvignon – 2014, Kamen Estate, Moon Mountain, Sonoma County Concentrated notes of wild blueberries, ripe plum and violets with dense, rich flavors such as roasted herbs and meats, graphite and milk chocolate. This elegant wine was made for cellaring but very approachable in its youth. 96 pts Robert Parker.			117.00
40. Zinfandel – 2014, “Rapsallion”, League of Rogues, Paso Robles Ripe aromas of cherry, raspberry, cinnamon and chocolate. The flavor profile is driven by vibrant red fruit flavors and bright acidity. Structured with sweet oak tannin and a nice cocoa flavor finish	2.50	10.00	31.00
