19. Pinot Noir- 2014 Outlier, North Coast The fruit for this lighter bodied pinot noir is sourced from three separate vineyards and displays notes of cherry, herb and rose petals with refreshing acidity on the palate.	3.25	13.00	38.00
20. Pinot Noir- 2012 Handley Cellars, Anderson Valley Deep aromas of cherry pie, cola and orange peel lead the way for the full flavors of tart black cherry, pomegranate, boysenberry and a slight herbaceous note.	3.75	15.00	42.00

Pinot Noir- 2013 Testarossa, "Dos Rubios Vineyard," Santa Lucia Highlands Ripe cherry and currant flavors abound in this Pinot Noir that is both lush and expansive, while the youthful and lively tannins give way to extended age potential. 22. Trousseau- 2013 Comanche Cellars, San Benito County This unique varietal native to northeastern France is grown here locally near Tres Pinos. Bright and acid driven, this wine shows notes of baking spice, cinnamon and white pepper on the nose and leads to a light and bright palate of red chili and spice. Extremely limited with only 25 cases produced.	2.50	10.00	31.00
23. Merlot- 2013 Bench, Knights Valley, Sonoma County Brilliant ruby hue and complex nose that shares aromas of black cherry, ripe plum and cedar. The palate is creamy and lushly textured. Flavors of rhubarb, dark forest fruit and earth linger on an elegant finish.	2.75	11.00	34.00
24. Tempranillo- 2012 Bodegas "Viva Yo!", Paso Robles Bold cherry and plum with hints of smoke and leather, layered with spices you expect from Tempranillo. 2012 brought soft tannins and bright fruit to this Paso favorite.	3.00	12.00	37.00
25. Cabernet Franc- 2013 Lieu Dit, Santa Ynez Valley Even the most adventurous palates are likely to appreciate this cooler, more vegetal side of Cabernet Franc. Notes of savory herbs, graphite, crushed rocks and blackberries meld together nicely in the glass.	4.25	17.00	47.00
26. Grenache- 2011 Mathis, Sonoma Valley Beautiful blend of fresh fruits, raspberry jam, white pepper and a kiss of thyme, followed by a zingy vibrant compote of cherries, framboise and dried currants. Balanced with fresh acidity and silky soft tannins.	3.50	14.00	40.00
27. Lagrein- 2014 Harrington, Paso Robles Another great find from one of our favorite wineries in San Francisco! Native to the valleys of Northern Italy, Lagrein is a rare grape for California. This velvety, inky blue-black wine shows off a soft palate but has well defined tannins that make this full bodied wine easy to pair with foods. Aromas of black cherry, sour plum and violets give way to soft leather and chocolate notes.	4.50	18.00	49.00
28. Syrah- 2013 Black Sheep Finds "Hocus Pocus", Santa Barbara County With only 500 cases produced, this wine shows classic floral notes with a dusty nose and dark berry fruit in its medium-bodied, fresh and elegant profile.	3.25	13.00	38.00
29. GSM- 2014 League of Rogues "Absent Minded Professor", Paso Robles 17% Grenache, 52% Syrah, and 17% Mourvedre, and 14% Viognier. This medium bodied French style wine featuring California fruit, with characteristic of cherry, spice, and mocha. The finish lingers on the palate, popping with bright acidity and moderate to heavy oak tannin.	2.25	9.00	29.00
30. Mourvèdre – 2013 Seven Oxen Estate Wines, Paso Robles Consisting of 90% Mourvèdre and 10% Grenache, this elegant wine shows characteristics true to varietal with notes of black pepper, leather and candied fruits. The full-bodied nature of Mourvèdre is balanced by the subtle fruitiness from the Grenache that makes the flagship wine from this small, sustainably farmed vineyard complex and well-rounded, full of dark fruits and the perfect pairing for all your summer BBQ's! 31. Cabernet Blend- 2011 Seka Hills "Tuluk'a", Capay Valley Made by one of our favorite olive oil and vinegar producers, this red blend features notes of strawberry followed by a toasty oak finish. With 51% Cabernet Sauvignon and 30% Syrah, this wine also shows characteristics from smaller amounts of Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot and Petite Sirah.	2.50	10.00	31.00
32. Cabernet Sauvignon- 2012 Broadside, San Luis Obispo 54% Cabernet, 42% Merlot and 4% Petite Verdot, this wine is sourced from the same vineyards that acclaimed winery Justin uses for their Isosceles blend. Notes of tobacco and freshly tilled earth marry perfectly with plum, clove and cherry on the palate.	3.25	13.00	38.00
33. Cabernet Sauvignon- 2011 Seavey Vineyard "Caravina", Napa Valley A true hidden gem of the Napa Valley produced in the secluded Conn Valley, this wine shows off exemplary style of mountain fruit balanced by elegant tannins. A splash of Petit Verdot lends a deep ruby hue. While excellent now, this wine was produced with long cellar aging in mind.	4.75	19.00	51.00
34. Zinfandel- 2013 Peter Franus, Lake County This classic representation of the varietal grown high on the slopes of Cobb Mountain shows off a nose full of dusty fruit and full of clove, white pepper and spice. Well balanced with big tannins, this wine will surely age with grace.	3.50	14.00	40.00
35. Zinfandel- 2012 Bella Vineyards, Dry Creek Valley This rustic, classic and approachable wine is comprised of 89% Zinfandel and 11% Petite Sirah. Bright red fruits such as cranberries and pomegranate lead to a savory palate full of thyme and white pepper.	3.50	14.00	40.00
36. Petite Sirah- 2006 Corté Riva, Lake County and Napa Only 300 cases were made of this big and powerful wine full of earthy aromatics that lead to dense flavors of cassis, black cherry, anise and black pepper. The evolved tannins show a great aging potential.	4.25	17.00	47.00
