## whites *Wines are listed from lightest to fullest.*

### 1. Sparkling Brut - Breathless, NV, North Coast

Wonderful yeasty notes on the nose, leading to lovely flavors of pear and citrus; Methode Champenoise; Chardonnay, Pinot Blend.

### 2. Trousseau Gris - 2012 Falcor, Russian River Valley

Notes of green melon, peach, and tropical fruit give way to a soft palate with minerality on the finish. An obscure varietal grown only in one vineyard in California; only a few wineries use this bright fruit.

### 3. Sauvignon Blanc – 2010 Cornerstone, Napa Valley

Vibrant and rich with zesty notes of lemon peel and grapefruit with balanced minerality. Clean, crisp finish.

### 4. Rosé - 2012 Blackbird, Napa Valley

38% Merlot, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 26% Cabernet Franc make up this Bordeaux inspired Rose sourced from several premiere Napa vineyards. Notes of bright strawberry lead to citrus and a refreshing minerality on the palate.

### 5. Albariño - 2012 Bodegas "Galicia," Edna Valley

Pronounced pear and peach combine with a floral hint on the nose followed by juicy apple on the palate and a creamy finish.

### 6. Chardonnay - 2011 Lost Canyon, Russian River Valley

A beautiful single vineyard Chardonnay from the Ruxton Vineyard planted in 1977. This wine starts off with notes of lemon and creme brûlée leading to a buttery, oaky finish with hints of citrus.

### 7. Chardonnay – 2011 Shadowbrook, San Francisco Bay

Estate grown fruit. Tropical aromas of pineapple and kiwi. Well balanced notes of vanilla and oak. Double Gold award in Elite category. Winery is located in Walnut Creek.

### 8. Riesling - 2011 Santa Barbara Winery, Santa Rita Hills

Ripe fruit aromas of apricots and notes of jasmine. Off-dry in style with initial sweetness on the palate, a nectar-like mouth feel, nice minerality, balancing out with nice acid.

### 9. Pinot Noir – 2011 Monticello, Napa Valley

Aromatics and taste are dominated by ripe berry and black cherries. The flavors follow with raspberry and hints of strawberry. The texture is rich and elegant finishing long on the palate.

### 10. Meritage - 2010 Medlock Ames, Bell Mountain Ranch, Alexander Valley

A sumptuous blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (75%), Merlot (20%), and Cab Franc (5%). Handcrafted and organically produced with aromas of black fruit, a hint of clove and spice, flavors of cherry and cocoa.

### 11. Cabernet Franc – 2010 Monticello, Napa Valley

Offers aromatics of spice, cloves and anise. The flavors follow berry, currant and a little jam. The wine has a mid-weight attack, medium to full body. The tannins are well-integrated and well-balanced.

### 12. Spanish Style Blend - 2009 Bodegas "Vaca Negra", Paso Robles

Made up of 43% Mourvedre, 36% Tempranillo, and 21% Grenache this blend offers up a spicy nose with pronounced cedar and black fruit. The finish is dark and juicy, with a hint of coffee.

### 13. Zinfandel – 2011 David Coffaro, Dry Creek Valley

An unfiltered medium bodied zinfandel expressive of the Dry Creek appellation; wild berry flavors, balanced acidity, spice, complex oak and a lasting finish of white pepper.

### 14. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2010 Stepping Stone, Napa Valley

A gorgeously vibrant nose of red berry fruit, subtle spice with hints of dried herbs combine with a lush, silky, mouth watering palate with smooth, subdued tannins.

### 15. Red Blend – 2010, Shadowbrook "Encore", San Francisco Bay

Malbec, Petite Verdot and Petite Syrah combine to make this an aromatic gem. Full of black fruit flavors with a hint of anise and mocha with nice tannins. Winery is located in Walnut Creek.

### 16. Syrah - 2010 MacLaren, Drouthy Neebors, Sonoma County

Layers of blackcurrants with spicy cloves and boxwood and a hint of smoked meat. A nicely balanced palate showing the fruit, mineral, floral and spice elements equally. Blackcurrants and cherries, boxwood, violet and clove. A long fruit finish mixed with
