<b>22. Pinot Noir – 2014 Handley Cellars, Anderson Valley</b> Aromas of Bing cherry pie, dried rose petal, and baking spices precede flavors of raspberry, sour plum and a nutmeg. The finish is long and lingering punctuated by bright acidity.	3.25	13.00	38.00
<b>23. Pinot Noir - 2014 Lucienne, Smith Vineyard, Santa Lucia Highlands</b> A perfect expression of California Pinot Noir. Dark cherry, cinnamon, clove aromas with chocolate, rhubarb and cola on the palate.	4.75	19.00	51.00
<b>24. Trousseau – 2015, Harrington, San Benito County</b> This rare varietal is grown in minute quantities in California. Known for rich red fruit flavors such as raspberry and cranberry, finishing in a slight kick of black pepper.	3.75	15.00	42.00
<b>25. Barbera – 2012, Enotria, Mendocino County</b> Juicy blackberries and red currant with hints of earth and toasty oak. Medium tannins and a great natural acidity lead into a finish that is clean and mouthwatering.	3.00	12.00	37.00
<b>26. GSM – 2014, “Absent Minded Professor”, League of Rogues, Paso Robles</b> Made from 17% Grenache, 52% Syrah, 17% Mourvèdre and 15% Albariño. This medium French style wine featuring California fruit, with characteristics of Bing Cherry, spice and mocha.	2.25	9.00	29.00
<b>27. Merlot – 2012 Toby Lane Vineyards, Alexander Valley</b> Aromas of currant, red plum, and dark chocolate, with impeccably balanced acidity supporting intense fruit forward flavors. Round, supple tannins contribute to a lingering finish.	3.75	15.00	42.00
<b>28. Merlot – 2013, “Pépé” Y. Rousseau, Moon Mountain District, Sonoma Valley</b> The nose is crowded with sugarplums, violet petals and a freshly opened pack of fig newtons. The flavors of strawberry rhubarb pie slip into blueberries dusted in fine black pepper.	6.25	25.00	85.00
<b>29. Tempranillo– 2012, “¡Viva Yo!” Bodegas, Paso Robles</b> With 90% Tempranillo and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine features bold cherry and plum flavors with hints of smoke and leather, layered with the spice nuances you expect from a Tempranillo. The 2012 vintage brought soft tannins and bright fruit to this Paso Robles favorite.	3.25	13.00	38.00
<b>30. Malbec – 2014, Berryessa Gap, Yolo County</b> Spicy dark fruit dominate this wine. Inky purple in color with aromas of blackberry, plum, cedar, dust and smoke jump out of the glass.	3.00	12.00	37.00
<b>31. Cabernet Franc – 2014 Carr Winery, Santa Ynez Valley</b> This wine shows off an incredible balance between tannins and acid, with a nose full of green pepper, blueberry and chocolate. Rich flavors of black cherries and cassis.	3.75	15.00	42.00
<b>32. Red Blend – 2011, “Summit” Powell Mountain Cellars, Paso Robles</b> A blend of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Syrah, the ‘Summit’ blend offers a pleasant balance of fruit and structure. Dark black cherry and licorice aromas accentuate a palate of cherry, mocha, and subtle oak.	4.00	16.00	44.00
<b>33. Cabernet Sauvignon - 2014 Dewitt Family, Alexander Valley</b> This classic example of Cabernet Sauvignon will display hardy plum and strong oak notes, with a rich mouth feel, and an exceptionally long finish. 300 cases produced.	4.00	16.00	44.00
<b>34. Cabernet Sauvignon - 2014 Silver Ghost, Napa Valley</b> Named in honor of the winemakers’ great grandfather, who helped launch the Silver Ghost Rolls Royce, the pedigree of this classic Cabernet Sauvignon truly exceeds itself with lush texture and opulent tannins. Complex aromas of black cherry, smoked herbs and coffee on the nose lead to a rich mouthfeel, well-integrated tannins and velvet fruit flavors.	4.75	19.00	51.00
<b>35. Syrah – 2009 Saxon Brown, Sonoma Coast</b> Wonderful violet, lavender and dark exotic fruits are showcased in this classic style Syrah from the Sonoma Coast. The palate leads to tart berry flavors and a dark chocolate finish.	3.50	14.00	40.00
<b>36. Syrah – 2012 “The Octopod”, Furlong Estates, Alexander Valley</b> This well-balanced Syrah offers aromas of dark berries and black current. A hint of spice, rich plum flavors and a pronounced tannin structure leads to a long, complex finish.	2.75	11.00	34.00
<b>37. Zinfandel – 2014, “Rapsallion”, League of Rogues, Paso Robles</b> Ripe aromas of cherry, raspberry, cinnamon and chocolate. The flavor profile is driven by vibrant red fruit flavors and bright acidity. Structured with sweet oak tannin and a nice cocoa flavor finish	2.50	10.00	31.00
<b>38. Zinfandel - 2013 Paro, Russian River Valley</b> A beautiful selection from the acclaimed Bacigalupi Vineyard in the Russian River Valley. Aromas of blackberries, clove and leather with a palate of dark cherry and a luscious mouth feel.	3.75	15.00	42.00
<b>39. Petite Sirah – 2013 “Labyrinth” Haka, Paso Robles</b> Distinctive blackberry, black licorice, plum and spicy fruit. Soft brown sugar nuances on the nose add a sweet complexity with soft and tannin and acidity for a beautiful finish.	3.25	13.00	38.00
