20. Pinot Noir – 2014 Handley Cellars, Anderson Valley Aromas of Bing cherry pie, dried rose petal, and baking spices precede flavors of raspberry, sour plum and a nutmeg. The finish is long and lingering punctuated by bright acidity.	3.25	13.00	38.00
21. Trousseau – 2016, Harrington, San Benito County This rare varietal is grown in minute quantities in California. Known for rich red fruit flavors such as raspberry and cranberry, finishing in a slight kick of black pepper.	3.75	15.00	42.00
22. Barbera – 2013, Enotria, Mendocino County Juicy blackberries and red currant with hints of earth and toasty oak. Medium tannins and a great natural acidity lead into a finish that is clean and mouthwatering.	3.00	12.00	37.00
23. Merlot – 2012, Toby Lane Vineyards, Alexander Valley Aromas of currant, red plum, and dark chocolate, with impeccably balanced acidity supporting intense fruit forward flavors. Round, supple tannins contribute to a lingering finish.	3.75	15.00	42.00

Tempranillo– 2013, “¡Viva Yo!” Bodegas, Paso Robles With 90% Tempranillo and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine features bold cherry and plum with hints of smoke and leather, layered with the spices you expect from Tempranillo. 29. Red Blend – 2014, Calluna Cuvée, Chalk Hill, Sonoma County A traditional Bordeaux style blend consisting of 47% Merlot, 26% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cab Franc, 9% Malbec and 8% Petite Verdot. 33. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2014, Dewitt Family, Alexander Valley This classic example of Cabernet Sauvignon will display hardy plum and strong oak notes, with a rich mouth feel, and an exceptionally long finish. Only 300 cases produced!	4.00	16.00	44.00

Cabernet Sauvignon – 2014, Silver Ghost, Napa Valley Named in honor of the winemakers’ great grandfather, who helped launch the Silver Ghost Rolls Royce, the pedigree of this classic Cabernet Sauvignon truly exceeds itself with lush texture and opulent tannins. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2014, Kamen Estate, Moon Mountain, Sonoma County Concentrated notes of wild blueberries, ripe plum and violets with dense, rich flavors such as roasted herbs and meats, graphite and milk chocolate. 38. Zinfandel – 2014, “Rapsallion”, League of Rogues, Paso Robles Ripe aromas of cherry, raspberry, cinnamon and chocolate. The flavor profile is driven by vibrant red fruit flavors and bright acidity. Structured with sweet oak tannin and a nice cocoa flavor finish	2.50	10.00	31.00

4. Sparkling Brut Rosé – 2010 Caraccioli Cellars, Santa Lucia Highlands Light and expressive, a soft fruit complexity and a balanced acid structure. With smells of baking bread, nectarine and strawberries and a beautiful coral and pink hue. This wine won Best US Sparkling Vintage Rosé for the 2017 “Champagne & Sparkling Wine World Championships.”			80.00
5. Sauvignon Blanc - 2016 Hill Family Estate, Napa Valley Organic and classic in style. This light, refreshing wine is full of citrus notes and a fresh grass finish with rambunctious acidity.	2.25	9.00	29.00
6. Sauvignon Blanc – 2014 Origine, Central Coast Consisting of 90% Sauvignon Blanc and 10% Verdelho this wine holds notes of gooseberry, lime zest and wet stone. The palate is well balanced with vibrant acidity and elegant structure. Flavors of citrus, lemongrass, and passionfruit linger on the finish.	2.00	8.00	27.00

Albariño – 2016 League of Rogues, “The Tortured Artist,” Paso Robles Made in the traditional Rías Baixas style, this Spanish varietal not typically grown in California hails from a SIP Certified vineyard down on the Central Coast. Notes of tangerine and mandarin orange with a slightly salty characteristic, this wine is vibrant with a medium acidity.	2.50	10.00	31.00
9. Pinot Grigio- 2015 Montevolpe, Mendocino County Floral and citrus aromas give way to flavors of white peaches and nectarine on the palate.	2.50	10.00	31.00
10. Pinot Gris- 2014 Hope & Grace, Russian River Valley Aromas of green apples and fresh melon with hints of white pepper, lime zest and tropical fruit. Mouth-filling texture floods the palate with citrus, apple and stone minerality. Only 125 cases produced!	3.00	12.00	37.00
11. Rosé – 2017 Skinner Vineyards, El Dorado County This light, dry-style rosé is produced from 47% Grenache, 23% Mourvèdre, 16% Counoise and 14% Cinsault. Tart and refreshing acidity with notes of pink grapefruit and cranberry balanced by softer flavors of rose petal and strawberries.
