<p>2. “Grandpa Tractor” Dortmund-Style Export Lager, Barley Forge Brewing, Costa Mesa CA This nearly extinct style of beer is our replacement for a classic pilsner. Aromas of fresh-cut hay and shortbread cookies compliment a light malty flavor and a mild hop profile. Subtly sweet and crisp, this beer will leave you begging for another sip.</p>	5.0%	12 oz	7.00
<p>3. “Blue Star” American Wheat Beer, North Coast Brewing Co., Fort Bragg CA Hailing from foggy Fort Bragg, CA this American Style wheat beer is unfiltered and playfully effervescent. <p>4. “.394” Pale Ale, Alesmith Brewing Company, San Diego CA Brewed with direct input from Tony Gwynn, this ale is a tribute to the highest single-season batting average he set back in 1994. An initially intense citrus hopiness settles into a mellow floral finish. A portion of the proceeds are donated to the Tony and Alicia Gwynn Foundation.</p>	6.0%	12 oz	7.00

<p>6. Belgian Wheat Beer, Allagash White, Portland, Maine Brewed with a generous portion of wheat and spiced with coriander and Curacao orange peel, this beer is fruity, refreshing and slightly cloudy.</p>	5.2%	12 oz	7.00

<p>8. “Windy Hill” New England Style India Pale Ale, Mikkeller, San Diego A Dry-hopped IPA brewed in San Diego using Simcoe and Mosaic hops with a distinctly hazy appearance in the glass and fresh floral and pine notes on the nose.
