1. We Olive Peach Basil Mimosa or Seasonal Mimosa Sweetened with our We Olive Peach White Balsamic Vinegar with aromatics from our Fresh Basil Olive Oil! Ask your server about our current selection of seasonal mimosas.	12.00	
2. Amaro Spritz Refreshing and bubbly! Lo-Fi Gentian Amaro, a wine-based aperitif with natural herbs and botanicals from Napa with hibiscus and ginger notes. Topped with sparkling wine and an orange slice.	13.00	
3. Harvest Spritz A fun and festive sparkling cocktail is made with a seasonal Kumquat Aperitif from Mommenpop wines in Napa, topped with sparkling wine and a cinnamon sugar rim.	14.00	
4. Sparkling Brut – NV Breathless Wines, North Coast 46% Chardonnay, 50% Pinot Noir, 4% Pinot Meunier. This bubbly is aged 12 months using traditional méthode champenoise. With a slight rosy hue and a soft yeastiness, this wine is sure to dance on the palate.	16.00	44.00
5. Sparkling Brut Rosé – 2021 Breaking Bread, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma Made in the Pétillant Naturel style, French for “Natural Sparkling,” this bubbly rosé is made from 100% Zinfandel fruit. Passion fruit and Bing cherry on the nose with nice minerality and easy-drinking effervescence.	16.00	44.00
6. Sparkling Red – 2021 ‘Rouge Brut’, Carboniste, Napa Valley A fun take on a sparkling wine! Made from Merlot and Albarniño fruit fermented separately, blended and bottled together with fresh yeast to create this ultra-cool wine with notes of juicy cherry, red apple and blackberry. Like a classy Lambrusco with the refined bubbles of a traditional sparkler.	18.00	49.00
7. Sauvignon Blanc – 2022 Oak Farm Vineyards, Lodi Well balanced with vibrant acidity and elegant structure. Aromas of pineapple, lemongrass and guava. With a crisp mouthfeel full of tropical fruit, sweet basil and ripe peach flavors lifted by nice acidity and a clean, lengthy finish.	10.00	31.00
8. Viognier – 2022 Bella Grace Vineyards, Amador County Very fun with lovely aromas of honeysuckle, vanilla and peach. Tropical flavors and a nice balance of acidity with a little tang. Aged in a 400-ton concrete egg to smooth out the palate and add a little minerality. Only 170 cases produced!	14.00	40.00
9. Grüner Veltliner – 2020 Tatomer ‘Meeresboden’, Santa Barbara One of our favorite producers, specializing in classic representations of German and Austrian varietals, grown in the cool climate Central Coast of California. ‘Meeresboden,’ which translates to “Ocean Soil” in German, is balanced with stone fruit, citrus, a distinct salinity and minerality. Bright and racy acidity. 93 Pts <i>Wine Enthusiast</i> .	15.00	42.00
10. Clairette – 2021 Samsara, Santa Barbara Just 128 cases produced of this obscure and very cool Rhône varietal. Bright florals on the nose with lemon zest and guava. Racy acidity with notes of lychee, green pear and a chalky minerality to give it some weight. 93 Pts <i>Wine Enthusiast</i>	16.00	44.00
11. White Blend – 2022 Giornata ‘Il Campo Bianco,’ Paso Robles Inspired by the Italian coastal white wines, this blend of mostly Falanghina, with some Fiano, Arneis, Vermentino and Pinot Grigio blended in for a full bodied wine with notes of butterscotch, macadamia and lemon peel.	14.00	40.00
12. Chardonnay – 2021 La Follette, ‘Los Primeros’, Monterey & Sonoma County A well-balanced California chardonnay with aromas of white flowers, honeydew and fresh peaches. Soft oak and buttery notes on the palate are balanced by bright citrus and floral aromas.	15.00	42.00
13. Rosé of Grenache – 2021 Mathis, Sonoma Valley A pale, salmon color made in the classic Provençal style. Produced from 100% grenache grapes grown on the Mathis estate vineyard. A lovely and fresh dry rosé with aromas of crushed raspberries and watermelon.	15.00	42.00
14. Rosé – 2022 Bella Grace Vineyards, Amador County A lovely bubble-gum pink color, made from 60% estate grown Grenache and 40% Estate Grown Mourvèdre. Soft notes of watermelon and strawberries on the nose with bright acid and well-balanced tannins.	13.00	38.00
15. Rosé – 2021 Trujillo Wines, ‘Madelyn,’ Napa and Mendocino Counties Blend of 34% Grenache, 32% Malbec, 29% Pinot Noir and a little each of Sauvignon Blanc and Gewürztraminer for some aromatics. Beautiful jewel-toned color with bright, fresh red fruit flavors of strawberry, red raspberry, and pomegranate.	13.00	38.00
16. Orange Wine – 2021 Union Sacre, Arroyo Seco Made from 100% Gewürztraminer with a beautiful color of orange sherbet and a nose that smells like perfume and orange blossom. The grapes were aged on the skins for 40 days to add some structure, the color and a bit of saltiness to perfect this deliciously dry wine.	11.00	35.00
17. Orange Wine – 2022, Giornata ‘Orangotango,’ Paso Robles Made from organic white grapes that were fermented on the skins to give this wine a lovely amber hue and to add a bit of tannin. Fun and exotic aromas of creamsicle and mango with a taste of tart orange marmalade and white pepper.	15.00	42.00
18. Moscato – 2022 Enotria, Mendocino Fragrant, light, and slightly sweet. Aromas of fresh peaches, freesia, and a little lime zest to add some acidity for balance.	8.00	28.00
