<p>16. Chillable Red – 2023 Jolie Laide ‘Gloud d’Etat’, Northern California</p> <p>This unique chilled red is made of a wide array of varietals that comes from a plethora of vineyards throughout Northern California. With 36% Valdiguié, 22% Mourvèdre, 18% Cinsault, and 16% Grenache, it provides an easy-drinking experience. Notes cherry, plum, cranberry and lavender come through with fresh and lifted acidity.</p>	17.00	46.00
<p>17. Chillable Red – 2022 Field Recordings ‘Freddo’, Paso Robles</p> <p>Made up of predominantly Sangiovese, it leads with notes of fresh cranberry, cherries, and strawberries. Think Jello shooters, but for wine! It is light and refreshing but has a tangy and tannic finish. Recommended to be served chilled – when the label turns blue, you know what to do.</p>	14.00	40.00
<p>18. Pinot Noir – 2021 Gallegos, Monterey County</p> <p>Grown in the Santa Lucia Highlands area of Monterey, this deeply colored wine opens with rich and layered flavors of strawberry and rhubarb pie, cranberry and cherry with fresh acidity. Nice soft velvety tannins make for a plush wine and a smooth finish.</p>	17.00	46.00
<p>19. Red Blend – 2021 Clesi, ‘Son of a Son,’ Paso Robles</p> <p>Made from 54% Sangiovese, 41% Aglianico, and 5% Barbera. These classic Italian heritage varietals are not widely produced in California. Together they make a robust but lighter bodied wine with bright acidity and a good balance of fruit from the addition of Barbera.</p>	14.00	40.00
<p>20. GSM – 2020 Land of Saints, Santa Barbara County</p> <p>Grown from biodynamic, organic grapes and SIP certified. 35% Grenache, 40% Syrah, 25% Mourvèdre. Lighter on the palate with some juicier notes of blackberry, peppercorn and bright red fruits.</p>	16.00	44.00
<p>21. Cabernet Franc – 2021 Union Sacre, Paso Robles</p> <p>Fun, juicy and lively with red plum, blackberry, violets and a hint of green pepper. Sharp acidity and firm tannins provide structure to the rich, fruit flavors. A long smooth finish makes for a versatile wine that pairs nicely with a variety of foods.</p>	12.00	37.00
<p>22. Syrah – 2021 Falcone Family Vineyards, Paso Robles</p> <p>Made from 94% Syrah and just a touch of Petite Sirah, this dark and hearty wine has rich aromas of blueberry jam, black plum and cassis. 94 pts <i>Wine Enthusiast</i></p>	17.00	46.00
<p>23. Tempranillo – 2021 ‘Quinta Cruz’ Pierce Ranch, San Antonio Valley</p> <p>This wine has a great amount of cranberry, pomegranate, and sour cherry fruit with nuances of smoky-earthly spices. It has an intense and complex flavor profile that makes it great for food pairing.</p>	13.00	38.00
<p>24. Red Blend – 2021 Hourglass ‘HG III Proprietary Blend,’ Napa Valley</p> <p>A core blend of Merlot, Petite Sirah and Cabernet Sauvignon. Rich, elegant and concentrated with a balance of acidity and refined structure and tannins. Notes of cocoa powder and deep plum, black cherry and cola.</p>	20.00	69.00
<p>25. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2022 Groundwork Wine Co., Paso Robles</p> <p>88% Cabernet Sauvignon and 12% Petite Verdot. Notes of blackberry, blueberry, currant, and black tea leaf. Spent 18 months in Neutral French Oak. A beautifully bold wine with a tannic finish.</p>	13.00	38.00
<p>26. Zinfandel – 2022 Portalupi ‘Shake Ridge Ranch,’ Amador County</p> <p>Rich and smooth with aromas of dark cherry, tarragon and chocolate. Inky in color with subtle spice notes and nicely balanced tannins and a soft oak presence.</p>	15.00	42.00

<p>27. 2016 Hoot Owl Creek Vineyards</p> <p>Big jammy nose offers plum and boysenberry aromas with caramel and cassis filling in as it opens up. Rich, centered palate with sweet oak, black olive and bold fruit. Finishes with a nice core of ripe tannins.</p>		90.00
<p>28. 2021 Vineyard 29 Cru</p> <p>Enticing aromas of Bing cherry, dried lavender and roasted coffee beans awaken the senses and set the stage for a palate of ripe blackberry and cherry. Subtle flavors of oak show itself with notes of cedar, allspice, and sandalwood. This wine is structured to age for decades but is also delicious and full bodied upon release.</p>		87.00
