<p>1. We Olive Peach Basil Mimosa or Seasonal Mimosa</p> <p>Sweetened with our We Olive Peach White Balsamic Vinegar with aromatics from our Fresh Basil Olive Oil! Ask your server about our current selection of seasonal mimosas.</p>	13.00	
<p>2. Amaro Spritz</p> <p>Refreshing and bubbly! Lo-Fi Gentian Amaro, a wine-based aperitif with natural herbs and botanicals from Napa with hibiscus and ginger notes. Topped with sparkling wine and an orange slice.</p>	14.00	26.95
<p>3. Sparkling Brut – NV Breathless Wines, North Coast</p> <p>46% Chardonnay, 50% Pinot Noir, 4% Pinot Meunier. This bubbly is aged 12 months using traditional méthode champenoise. With a slight rosy hue and a soft yeastiness, this wine is sure to dance on the palate.</p>	16.00	44.00

Sparkling Brut Rosé – 2023 Breaking Bread, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma</p> <p>Made in the Pétillant Naturel style, French for “Natural Sparkling,” this bubbly rosé is made from 100% Zinfandel fruit. Passion fruit and Bing cherry on the nose with nice minerality and easy-drinking effervescence.</p>	16.00	44.00
<p>5. Sauvignon Blanc – 2022 Ehret Vineyards, Knights Valley</p> <p>Right off the bat, you will get mandarin zest on the nose! This enticing aroma continues onto the palate coupled with minerality. There is a lively zip of acidity that is followed by notes of key lime pie and juicy melon.</p>	14.00	40.00
<p>6. Albariño – 2023 La Marea ‘Kristy Vineyard’, Monterey</p> <p>Aromas of white nectarine and honeysuckle. Bright acidity leads on the palate and is followed by ripe pineapple and stone fruit. This wine is whole cluster pressed and cold fermented to preserve aromatics and freshness.</p>	14.00	40.00
<p>7. Dry Gewurztraminer – 2022 Husch Vineyards, Anderson Valley</p> <p>Far easier to drink than it is to pronounce! Features aromas of jasmine, rose petal and ginger. It has a bright acidity that carries through and provides a long and pleasant finish. Flavors of cut grass, yellow peach and jasmine add extra layers to the palate.</p>	12.00	37.00
<p>8. Grüner Veltliner Blend – 2022 Tatomer Hinter de Mauer, Central Coast</p> <p>80% Grüner Veltliner, 20% Dry Riesling. Quite tropical on the nose and the palate with hints of white flowers and a little bit of white pepper on the finish. A very clean and tropical wine.</p>	12.00	37.00
<p>9. Chardonnay – 2021 La Follette, ‘Los Primeros’, Monterey & Sonoma County</p> <p>A well-balanced California chardonnay with aromas of white flowers, honeydew and fresh peaches. Soft oak and buttery notes on the palate are balanced by bright citrus and floral aromas.</p>	15.00	42.00
<p>10. White Blend – 2022 Giornata ‘Il Campo Bianco,’ Paso Robles</p> <p>Inspired by the Italian coastal white wines, this blend of mostly Falanghina, with some Fiano, Arneis, Vermentino and Pinot Grigio blended in for a full bodied wine with notes of butterscotch, macadamia and lemon peel.</p>	14.00	40.00
<p>11. Rosé of Grenache – 2021 Mathis, Sonoma Valley</p> <p>A pale, salmon color made in the classic Provençal style. Produced from 100% grenache grapes grown on the Mathis estate vineyard. A lovely and fresh dry rosé with aromas of crushed raspberries and watermelon.</p>	15.00	42.00
<p>12. Rosé - 2022 Bella Grace Vineyards, Amador County</p> <p>A lovely bubble-gum pink color, made from 60% estate grown Grenache and 40% Estate Grown Mourvèdre. Soft notes of watermelon and strawberries on the nose with bright acid and well-balanced tannins.</p>	13.00	38.00
<p>13. Orange Wine – 2021 Union Sacre, Arroyo Seco</p> <p>Made from 100% Gewürztraminer with a beautiful color of orange sherbet and a nose that smells like perfume and orange blossom. Aged on the skins for 40 days to add some structure, color and a bit of saltiness to perfect this deliciously dry wine.</p>	11.00	35.00
<p>14. Orange Wine – 2023 Breaking Bread ‘Marmalade’, Dry Creek Valley</p> <p>Mostly made up of Muscat then blended with equal parts Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc, has a total of 10 days on the skin. The Chardonnay adds weight and complexity to the mouthfeel, while the Sauv Blanc brings in more acidity and higher notes. Balanced with notes of citrus and a bit of salinity.</p>	13.00	38.00
<p>15. Orange Wine – 2023 Giornata ‘Orangotango’, Paso Robles</p> <p>This wine defies expectation. Made up of Falanghina, Vermentino, and Fiano. Aromas of guava, orange zest and jasmine. On the palate there is mango, orange marmalade, and pink peppercorn.</p>	15.00	42.00
