19. Pinot Noir – 2019 BloodRoot, Sonoma An elegant cool coastal Pinot Noir using fruit from top vineyards around Sonoma, Mendocino and Russian River Valley to create a velvety wine with light cranberry and herbal notes. 93 pts <i>Wine Enthusiast</i>	3.25	13.00	38.00
20. Pinot Noir – 2017 Von Holt, Sonoma Coast Only 144 cases produced of this expressive wine with a nose full of Bing cherries and pomegranate. Nice and smooth on the palate with ripe raspberries and a lasting finish.	3.00	12.00	37.00

Pinot Noir - 2018 Testarossa, Santa Rita Hills Ripe cherry and currant flavors abound in this Pinot Noir that is both lush and expansive, while the youthful and lively tannins give way to extended age potential. Red Blend – 2019 Skinner, “Native Red”, El Dorado Hills A wild field blend made up of legacy grapes grown on the original estate back in the 1800's, predominately made from Mission, Petite Bouschet, Carignane and Trousseau, co-fermented with Viognier and Marsanne for a fun, mouthwatering and approachable red. Notes of raspberry and orange peel with a vivacious palate full of crushed cranberry and sweet plum. A fun alternative to Pinot Noir and lighter style wines.	2.50	10.00	31.00
23. Tempranillo - 2018 Bodegas “Viva Yo!”, Paso Robles Bold cherry and plum with hints of smoke and leather, layered with spices you expect from Tempranillo. This vintage brings soft tannins and bright fruit to this Paso favorite. 90% Tempranillo, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon	3.50	14.00	40.00
24. Red Blend – 2017 League of Rogues “Absent Minded Professor” 79% Zinfandel, 21% Syrah. This medium bodied wine featuring California fruit, with characteristic of cherry, spice, and mocha. Grown and produced down in Paso Robles.	2.75	11.00	35.00
25. Red Blend – 2018 Alma de Cattleya, Sonoma County 60% Syrah, 35% Merlot and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon. Rich and smooth with lush flavors of blackberries and blackcurrant. Super smooth tannins with cocoa and vanilla on the finish. Only 275 cases produced.	3.75	15.00	42.00
26. Malbec – 2019 “Shark Fin Red”, Beauregard Vineyards, Santa Cruz Made from 100% Malbec, this full-bodied wine is rich and juicy, with dark fruit notes. The palate has notes of bright fruit, blackberry, and vanilla spice.	3.25	13.00	38.00
27. Grenache – 2020 A Tribute to Grace, Santa Barbara County Made from 100% Grenache sourced from several different vineyard sites around the Central Coast. This wine brings bright acidity and deep, jammy fruit characteristics such as red raspberry jam and black cherry.	4.00	16.00	44.00
28. Charbono – 2020 Folk Machine, Suisun Valley Originally a French varietal now considered one of the few heritage grapes for California. Dark in color and heavy on the nose, but drinks light and pretty. Deep purple hue and aromas full of blackberries, blueberries and cassis.	3.00	12.00	37.00
29. Syrah – 2018 Hill Family Estate, Clarke Vineyard, Napa Valley Beautiful deep purple color in the glass with a smoky nose full of bacon, dark plum and black cherry. Rich and smooth palate with flavors of raspberry and chocolate.	4.25	17.00	47.00
30. Red Blend – 2018 Hourglass ‘HG III Proprietary Blend,’ Napa Valley A core blend of Merlot, Petite Sirah and Cabernet Sauvignon. Rich and concentrated with a balance of acidity and refined structure and tannins. Notes of cocoa powder and deep plum, black cherry and cola.	5.00	20.00	69.00
31. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2019 Silver Ghost, Napa Valley Named in honor of the winemakers' great grandfather, who launched the Silver Ghost Rolls Royce, the pedigree of this classic cab truly exceeds itself with lush texture and opulent tannins. Complex aromas of black cherry, smoked herbs and coffee on the nose lead to a rich mouthfeel, well-integrated tannins and velvet fruit flavors.	5.00	20.00	69.00
32. Zinfandel – 2019 ‘Shake Ridge Ranch’, Portalupi, Amador County A classic style Zinfandel with bright acidity coupled with vanilla, raspberry and white pepper notes. Bold and warm – full of baking spice and blackberry flavors with medium tannins and a strong finish.	3.75	15.00	42.00
33. Petite Sirah – 2020 Field Recordings ‘PETS’, Paso Robles Deep, dark and purple – this is a big wine full of black peppercorn, plum and blackberry. Lots of acid and tannins that help to balance out the dark juicy fruits and subtle oak notes.	2.75	11.00	35.00
