1. We Olive Mimosa

Try our signature mimosa flavors sweetened by our We Olive Peach White Balsamic Vinegar. Choose from our Fresh Basil olive oil or Blood Orange puree each paired with our seasonal vinegar.

2. S.I.P. Spritzer

Refreshing and bubbly! Lo-Fi Gentian Amaro, a wine-based aperitif with natural herbs and botanicals from Napa with hibiscus and ginger notes. Topped with sparkling wine and garnished with an orange.

3. Sparkling Brut – NV, Breathless Wines, Healdsburg

46% Chardonnay, 50% Pinot Noir, 4% Pinot Meunier, this bubbly is aged 12 months using the methode champenoise. With a slight rosy hue and a soft yeastiness, this wine is sure to dance on the palate.

4. Sparkling Brut Rosé – NV, Folktales Winery, Monterey County

Produced from 80% Chardonnay and 20% Pinot Noir, this elegant and fun sparkling wine holds a brilliant rose gold color with notes of watermelon, kiwi and a classic yeasty quality. Perfect for any occasion!

5. Sparkling Red – 2020 ‘Rouge Brute’, Carboniste, Napa Valley

A fun take on a sparkling wine! Made from Merlot and Albariño fruit fermented separately, blended and bottled together with fresh yeast to create this ultra-cool wine with notes of juicy cherry, red apple and blackberry. Like a classy Lambrusco with the refined bubbles of a traditional sparkler.

6. Riesling – 2019 Union Sacré Wines ‘Elsass’, Santa Barbara County

This dry style Riesling with fresh pear and Granny Smith apple notes and a nice balance of acidity. 100% of the fruit is harvested from Kick-On Ranch, a famously delicious spot for growing Alsatian varieties in California.

7. Picpoul – 2021 Bonny Doon Vineyards, Arroyo Seco, CA

A rarely found but increasingly popular grape varietal that originates from the south of France. Full of fresh acidity, a distinct saltiness and lime zest that balances with soft wildflower, peaches and a hint of spearmint.

8. Chenin Blanc – 2020 Folk Machine, Merritt Island, Clarksburg

Clean and crisp with notes of stone fruit and Meyer lemons. Balanced acidity and a nice minerality on the finish that makes for an excellent food pairing and refreshing, easy to drink option.

9. Sauvignon Blanc - 2020 Hill Family, Napa Valley

The palate is well balanced with vibrant acidity and elegant structure. Soft, light and refreshing with pineapple and white peach notes. Flavors of citrus, lemongrass, and passionfruit for a crisp, clean finish.

10. Rosé of Grenache – 2020 Mathis, Sonoma Valley

A pale salmon color made in the classic Provençal style. A lovely and fresh, dry rosé with aromas of crushed raspberries and white peach.

11. Rosé – 2020 Uphold Wines, Geyserville, CA

100% of profits are donated to support women’s rights. A blend of 40% Aglianico with a mix of Syrah, Grenache and Montepulciano. Bright, refreshing rosé with notes of red fruits.

12. Orange Wine – 2020 Field Recordings ‘SKINS’, Paso Robles

Made from mostly Chenin Blanc and Pinot Gris, this Orange wine, or grapes that have been fermented with their skins on to produce an amber color, is crisp with notes of apricot and marzipan.

13. White Blend – 2019 Gros Ventre ‘High Country White’, El Dorado

Lovely blend of 26% Arneis, 22% Grenache Blanc, 20% Fiano, 15% Picpoul, 10% Sauvignon Blanc and 7% Vermentino. Subtle hints of Chamomile, pears and Honeydew Melon leads to a palate full of bright acidity, lime zest and a distinct saltiness. Only 263 cases produced!

14. Petite Manseng – 2020 Y. Rousseau, Sierra Foothills, El Dorado

You are not alone if you have never heard of this super cool, rare varietal from the South of France! Just 175 cases were made of this supple and elegant white wine. Nose of pear, lychee and dried apricots with a rich mouthfeel full of texture and flavors of stone fruit and lemon curd followed by a long finish.

15. Albariño – 2020 League of Rogues, Paso Robles

Made in the traditional Rías Baixas style, this Spanish varietal features notes of tangerine and mandarin orange with a slightly salty characteristic, this wine is vibrant with a medium acidity. “Tortured Artist”

16. Chardonnay – 2019 Matias, Carneros, Napa Valley

Rich, golden color in the glass with a nose full of apple, lemon meringue and pear. With a little weight on the palate balanced by nice acidity with flavors of pastry crust and toasted almonds.

17. Chardonnay – 2019 Pence Ranch, St. Rita Hills, Santa Barbara

A refreshing and flavorful wine with bright notes of Meyer Lemons, Yuzu, and citrus blossoms. Tart but smooth on the palate with bright, focused acidity with stone fruit flavors and a nice, refreshing minerality.

18. Chardonnay - 2017 Testarossa ‘Fogstone’, SLH, Monterey

Pale straw in color with scents of ripe fig, apple, and butterscotch with a brisk and vibrant refreshing texture. An exclusive single-vineyard designate from one of our favorite neighbors!
