19. Sparkling Red – 2021 ‘Rouge Brute’ Carboniste, Napa Valley A fun take on a sparkling wine! Made from Merlot and Albariño fruit fermented separately, blended and bottled together with fresh yeast to create this ultra-cool wine with notes of juicy cherry, red apple and blackberry. Like a classy Lambrusco with the refined bubbles of a traditional sparkler.	4.25	17.00	37.00
20. Chilled Sangiovese – 2021 Union Sacré Wines, ‘Sangio,’ Paso Robles A super awesome lighter bodied red wine meant to be served chilled. With notes of Kool-Aid and cherry jolly rancher on the nose, this wine is surprisingly dry and not sweet at all. The perfect complement to a warm afternoon on the beach or by the pool – easy to drink and pairs with any kind of food (or fun!)	3.00	12.00	37.00
21. Pinot Noir – 2021 BloodRoot, Sonoma An elegant cool coastal Pinot Noir using fruit from top vineyards around Sonoma, Mendocino and Russian River Valley to create a velvety wine with light cranberry and herbal notes. 93 pts <i>Wine Enthusiast</i>	3.25	13.00	38.00
22. Pinot Noir – 2017 Von Holt, Sonoma Coast Only 144 cases produced of this expressive wine with a nose full of Bing cherries and pomegranate. Nice and smooth on the palate with ripe raspberries and a lasting finish.	3.00	12.00	37.00

Pinot Noir - 2019 Testarossa, Santa Rita Hills Ripe cherry and currant flavors abound in this Pinot Noir that is both lush and expansive, while the youthful and lively tannins give way to extended age potential. 24. Red Blend – 2019 Skinner, “Native Red”, El Dorado Hills A wild field blend made up of legacy grapes grown on the original estate back in the 1800’s, predominately made from Mission, Petite Bouschet, Carignane and Trousseau, co-fermented with Viognier and Marsanne for a fun, mouthwatering and approachable red. Notes of raspberry and orange peel with a vivacious palate full of crushed cranberry and sweet plum. A fun alternative to Pinot Noir and lighter style wines.	2.50	10.00	31.00
25. Red Blend – 2017 League of Rogues “Absent Minded Professor” 79% Zinfandel, 21% Syrah. This medium bodied wine featuring California fruit, with characteristic of cherry, spice, and mocha. Grown and produced down in Paso Robles.	2.75	11.00	35.00
26. Red Blend – 2019 Alma de Cattleya, Sonoma County 64% Syrah, 14% Merlot and 22% Cabernet Sauvignon. Rich and smooth with lush flavors of blackberries and blackcurrant. Super smooth tannins with cocoa and vanilla on the finish. Only 275 cases produced.	4.00	16.00	44.00
27. Red Blend – 2020 Margerum M5, Santa Barbara County A Rhône style blend based on Grenache, with additions of Syrah, Mourvedre, Cinsault and Counoise. Rich and dark flavors of jam, cocoa and dark berry fruits with a velvety finish and soft tannins.	4.00	16.00	44.00
28. Malbec – 2019 “Shark Fin Red”, Beauregard Vineyards, Santa Cruz Made from 100% Malbec, this full-bodied wine is rich and juicy, with dark fruit notes. The palate has notes of bright fruit, blackberry, and vanilla spice.	3.25	13.00	38.00
29. Grenache – 2020 A Tribute to Grace, Santa Barbara County Made from 100% Grenache sourced from several different vineyard sites around the Central Coast. This wine brings bright acidity and deep, jammy fruit characteristics such as red raspberry jam and black cherry.	4.00	16.00	44.00
30. Charbono – 2020 Folk Machine, Suisun Valley Originally a French varietal now considered one of the few heritage grapes for California. Dark in color and heavy on the nose, but drinks light and pretty. Deep purple hue, aromas of blackberries and cassis.	3.00	12.00	37.00
31. Barbera – 2019 Rossi-Wallace, Mendocino, CA A very classic representation of this Northern Italian varietal grown up in Northern California. Juicy and ripe with bright acid and a core of red berry fruits and a hint of spice. Only 112 cases produced.	4.00	16.00	44.00
32. Bordeaux-Style Blend – 2019 Hourglass ‘HG 111,’ Napa Valley A core blend of Merlot, Petite Sirah and Cabernet Sauvignon. Rich and concentrated with a balance of acidity and refined structure and tannins. Notes of cocoa powder and deep plum, black cherry and cola.	5.00	20.00	69.00
33. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2020 Gail Wines, Sonoma Valley Lush texture and opulent tannins. Complex aromas of black cherry, smoked herbs and coffee on the nose lead to a rich mouthfeel, well-integrated tannins and velvet fruit flavors.	3.75	15.00	42.00
34. Zinfandel – 2020 ‘Shake Ridge Ranch’, Portalupi, Amador County A classic style Zinfandel with bright acidity coupled with vanilla, raspberry and white pepper notes. Bold and warm – full of baking spice and blackberry flavors with medium tannins and a strong finish.	3.75	15.00	42.00
