19. Chilled Sangiovese – 2021 Union Sacré Wines, ‘Sangio,’ Paso Robles A super awesome lighter bodied red wine meant to be served chilled. 28. Bordeaux-Style Blend – 2021 Hourglass ‘HG III Proprietary Blend’, Napa Valley A core blend of Merlot, Petite Sirah and Cabernet Sauvignon. 29. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2021 Ultraviolet, Sonoma Valley Grown in the Red Hills AVA just east of St. Helena with 95% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Cabernet Franc. Soft and velvety with notes of blueberry and violets.	3.00	12.00	37.00

Cabernet Sauvignon – 2021 Silver Ghost, Napa Valley Named in honor of the winemakers’ great grandfather, who launched the Silver Ghost Rolls Royce, the pedigree of this classic cab truly exceeds itself with lush texture and opulent tannins.
