## 1. We Olive Mimosa

Try our signature mimosa flavors! Choose from Fresh Basil olive oil or Blood Orange puree each paired with our Peach White Balsamic vinegar.

## 2. Lo-Fi Spritzer

Refreshing and bubbly! Lo-Fi Gentian Amaro, a wine-based aperitif with natural herbs and botanicals from Napa with hibiscus and ginger notes. Topped with sparkling wine and garnished with an orange.

## 3. Harvest Spritz

A fun and festive sparkling cocktail is made with a Kumquat Aperitif from Mommenpop wines in Napa, topped with sparkling wine and a cinnamon sugar rim.

## 4. Sparkling Brut – NV Breathless Wines, Healdsburg

46% Chardonnay, 50% Pinot Noir, 4% Pinot Meunier, this bubbly is aged 12 months using the methode champenoise. With a slight rosy hue and a soft yeastiness, this wine is sure to dance on the palate.

## 5. Sparkling Rosé – 2021 Breaking Bread, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma

Made in the *Pétillant Naturel* style, French for “Natural Sparkling,” this bubbly rosé is made from 100% Zinfandel. Passion fruit and Bing cherry on the nose with nice minerality and easy-drinking effervescence.

## 6. Sparkling Red – 2021 ‘Rouge Brut’ Carboniste, Napa Valley

A fun take on a sparkling wine! Made from Merlot and Albariño fruit fermented separately, blended and bottled together with fresh yeast to create this ultra-cool wine with notes of juicy cherry, red apple and blackberry. Like a classy Lambrusco with the refined bubbles of a traditional sparkler.

## 7. Spanish-style White Blend – 2022 Orixe Sotelo, ‘Nebola,’ Monterey County

Made from 43% Albariño and 57% Arinto, this wine was made to simulate the fun, low alcohol, bright and slightly spritzy wines of the Spanish Basque region and Getariko Txakolina. Aromas of prickly pear and lime aromas with a mineral driven palate and a lightly bubbly wine that one would expect from a classic Txakolina.

## 8. Gewürtztraminer – 2021 Union Sacré, Paso Robles

A lovely nose full of lychee and white flower leads you to believe this will be a sweeter version but there is a pronounced acidity and tartness on the palate, with flavors of pineapple, grapefruit and ginger.

## 9. Grüner Veltliner – 2020 Tatomer, ‘Meeresboden,’ Santa Barbara

Grown in the cool climate Central Coast, ‘Meeresboden,’ which translates to “Ocean Soil” in German, is balanced with stone fruit, citrus, a distinct salinity and minerality. Bright and racy acidity. 93 Pts *WE*

## 10. Sauvignon Blanc - 2022 Dutton Estate Winery, Russian River, Sonoma Valley

Well balanced with vibrant acidity and elegant structure. Refreshing with pineapple and white peach notes with citrus and lemongrass for a crisp, clean finish.

## 11. Dry Riesling – 2021 Union Sacré, Paso Robles

This dry style Riesling with fresh pear and Granny Smith apple notes and a nice balance of acidity. 100% of the fruit is harvested from Kick-On Ranch, a famously delicious spot for growing Alsatian varietals in California.

## 12. Rosé of Grenache – 2021 Mathis, Sonoma Valley

A pale salmon color made in the classic Provençal style. A lovely and fresh, dry rosé with aromas of crushed raspberries and white peach.

## 13. Rosé of Grenache – 2022 Tribute to Grace, Santa Barbara Highlands

A light, dry-style rosé that is tart and refreshing with notes of strawberry rhubarb and cranberry balanced by rose petals and strawberries.

## 14. Orange Wine – 2021 Field Recordings ‘Domo Arigato (Mr.Ramato)’ Edna Valley

A ramato-style wine made from skin contact Pinot Gris grown on the Central Coast. Notes of fresh Pears and Apricot preserves with a hint of white pepper. Sustainable, Vegan, no additives, native yeast, and minimal sulfites... all the good stuff.

## 15. Orange Wine – 2022 Giornata Wines ‘OrangoTango,’ Paso Robles

Made from organic white grapes that were fermented on the skins to give this wine a lovely amber hue and to add a bit of tannin. Fun and exotic aromas of creamsicle and mango with a taste of tart orange marmalade and white pepper.

## 16. Orange Wine – 2021 Union Sacré, Paso Robles

Made from 100% Gewürtztraminer with a beautiful color of orange sherbet and a nose that smells like perfume and orange blossom. The grapes were aged on the skins for 40 days to add some structure, the color and a bit of saltiness to perfect this deliciously dry wine.

## 17. Chardonnay – 2020 Pence Ranch, St. Rita Hills, Santa Barbara

A refreshing, flavorful wine with bright notes of Meyer Lemons, Yuzu, and citrus blossoms. Tart but smooth on the palate with bright, focused acidity with stone fruit flavors and refreshing minerality.

## 18. Chardonnay – 2020 Testarossa ‘Fogstone,’ Santa Lucia Highlands, Monterey

Pale straw in color with scents of ripe fig, apple, and butterscotch with a brisk and vibrant refreshing texture. An exclusive single-vineyard designate from one of our favorite neighbors!
