14. Chilled Sangiovese – 2023 Union Sacré Wines, ‘Sangio’, Paso Robles A super awesome lighter bodied red wine meant to be served chilled. 17. Tempranillo – 2021 Quinta Cruz, San Antonio Valley, Monterey County Nice tart flavors of cranberry and pomegranate followed by a smokey, earthy spice. Classic style for this “Old-World” Spanish Varietal grown locally down in South Monterey County and produced in Santa Cruz.	3.75	15.00	45.00
18. Barbera – 2021 Bella Grace Vineyards, Amador County A beautiful dark garnet color with a nice weight in the glass, this silky wine is full of ripe cherry and dark plum flavors with a hint of chocolate and spice. Lovely mouthfeel with a long and juicy finish.	3.50	14.00	42.00
19. Red Blend – 2022 Clesi ‘Son of a Son,’ Paso Robles Delicious blend of 60% Sangiovese, 35% Aglianico and a touch of Barbera. From a certified organic and SIP certified vineyard, with a low-intervention winemaking approach. Savory notes of leather and white pepper add a rustic quality balanced out by soft fruit flavors of dried figs, red cherry and black fruits. 20. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2022 Groundwork, Paso Robles A standout wine with a deep crimson color and complex aromas that draw you in with notes of blackberry, black currant, and cassis fill the air with a mixture of roasted vanilla and spices.	3.75	15.00	45.00

Cabernet Sauvignon – 2022 Bedrock, Sonoma Valley The Bedrock Sonoma County Cabernet is a blend of declassified barrels from Montecillo and Monte Rosso barrels blended with some wine from the coastal Lichau Hill Vineyard.
