<b>1. We Olive Peach Basil Mimosa</b> Try our signature mimosa sweetened by our We Olive Peach White Balsamic Vinegar with aromatics from our Fresh Basil Olive Oil!		8.00	
<b>2. Sparkling Chardonnay – 2016, Scar of the Sea Pétillant-Naturel, Paso Robles, CA,</b> 100% Chardonnay, Aromas of sour apple, grass and passion fruit arise while the palate's very tight, bubbles unleash exotic tropical fruits like green papaya and green banana.			50.00
<b>3. Sparkling Brut – 2014, Argyle Vintage Brut, Willamette Valley, OR</b> 60% Pinot Noir and 40% Chardonnay grapes. Clean, crisp and bright, this wine was aged in stainless steel, providing fresh fruit flavors balanced by racy acidity and clean minerality.		10.00	45.00
<b>4. Arneis – 2017, Ruth Lewandowski “Mahlon”, Salt Lake City, UT</b> Literally translating to “Little Rascal”; Arneis gives out tons of green fruit notes. Apples, Pears, and Quince. Opening to some bright acid with a crunchy finish.	3.00	12.00	55.00
<b>5. Sauvignon Blanc – 2016, Walter Hansel, Lake County, CA</b> Notes of melon, fig and pears with a creamy undercurrent; the vibrant acidity will make it food friendly with a variety of dishes.	1.75	8.00	35.00
<b>6. Cortese – 2017, Ruth Lewandowski “Chilion”, Salt Lake City, UT</b> A captivating mix of apricots, golden apples, cognac spice, and candied orange rind make this “orange” wine super refreshing. Finishing with quince, baking spice, and crushed rocks	3.00	12.00	55.00
<b>7. Vermentino – 2016, Uvaggio, Lodi, CA</b> Aromas of snap peas, parsley, and fresh cut grass lead to lemon and grapefruit flavors and a tingly mouthfeel. Giving an almost electric charge to this light bodied, crisp and appetizing wine.	2.25	9.00	40.00
<b>8. Viognier – 2016, Cinder, Snake River Valley, ID</b> Elderberry flowers and lemon blossoms on the nose. The flavors take you into stone fruit, with white peach featured prominently. The body has good weight and the acid gives you a long and luxurious finish.	2.25	9.00	40.00
<b>9. Pinot Gris – 2016, Eyrie Vineyards, Dundee Hills, OR</b> Dense layers of lime, pea shorts, and white strawberry, finishing with a spicy uplift. Texture is round and full. The palate is dominated by ripe lychee and passionfruit	2.25	9.00	40.00
<b>10. Dry Riesling – 2016, Trefethen, Napa Valley, CA</b> Fragrant nose of jasmine and orange blossom. Dry, but succulent, the apple, lime and guava flavors are balanced and refreshing. Hint of minerality that animates the wine's long, lively finish	2.75	11.00	50.00
<b>11. Grüner Veltliner – 2015, Zocker, Edna Valley, CA</b> Rich and round with great acid, this wine is steely with pronounced minerality. Earthy characteristics come through with notes of white pepper, ripe melon, and fruit cocktail	2.50	10.00	45.00
<b>12. Albariño– 2016, Tagent, Edna Valley, CA</b> Irresistibly aromatic with layers of citrusy flavors and bright acidity. Mandarin oranges and tangerine peel run clear through to the finish. The round mouthfeel is beautifully balanced with a crisp acid structure.	2.25	9.00	40.00
<b>13. Rosé – 2016, Poe, Sonoma County, CA</b> 66% Pinot Noir, 34% Pinot Meunier 100% “direct to press”. Aromatics were preserved through the harvest and fermentation processes. The resulting wine reveals wild strawberries, peach, raspberry and citrus.	2.50	10.00	45.00
<b>14. Negroamaro Rosato – 2017, Martha Stoumen, Mendocino County, CA</b> This wine has an autumnal thread running through it. Aromas of sea air, prickly pears heavy with ripeness, and herbs drying in the golden autumn sun.	3.00	14.00	70.00
<b>15. Chardonnay – 2016, Scar of the Sea, Central Coast, CA</b> Aged in neutral French Oak. Notes of orchard and citrus fruits, flinty minerality, green apple and white pepper. Nice and zippy through the finish.	3.00	12.00	55.00
<b>16. Chardonnay – 2016, Fisher Vineyards, Sonoma &amp; Mendocino County, CA</b> Aromas of lemon custard and toasted almonds. The palate uniquely balances round rich flavors of ripe apple and honeyed lemongrass with subtle notes of lightly toasted oak	3.00	13.00	60.00
<b>17. White Blend – 2016, Donkey &amp; Goat “Gadabout”, North Coast, CA</b> The tangy pear, peach, and apricot flavors have a side of toast and spice. Set on a juicy frame, with roasted almond accents on the finish.	1.75	8.00	35.00

Pinot Nouveau – 2018, Poe, Sonoma County, CA</b> Pinot Nouveau is made in the style of Beaujolais Nouveau, the idea of celebrating the new vintage. The resulting wine is delicate and fruity, with aromas of rose petals and strawberry.	2.50	10.00	45.00
<b>19. Pinot Noir – 2016, Averaen, Willamette Valley, OR</b> Juicy black raspberry, cherry cola, lavender and spice cake flavors that become livelier on the back half. This Pinot finishes smooth and very long, featuring slow-building tannins and resonating floral notes.	2.50	10.00	45.00
<b>20. Red Blend – 2015, Forlorn Hope “Queen of the Sierras”, Calaveras County, CA</b> Barbera, Trousseau Noir, Tempranillo, Graciano, Cabernet Sauvignon are used to make this wine with dynamic tension between bright and forward fruit, supple tannins and lively acidity.	2.25	9.00	40.00
<b>21. Flora &amp; Fauna Red – 2017, Idlewild “The Bird”, Mendocino County, CA</b> 60% Dolcetto, 35% Barbera, 5% Nebbiolo Black cherries, wild strawberries, dried herbs, roses, fresh soil, and a touch of orange peel make up the aromatics. The mouth feel is bright and chewy giving way to firm acids.	2.50	10.00	45.00
<b>22. Red Blend – 2016, Enfield “Pretty Horses”, California</b> 80% Tempranillo 10% Graciano and 10% Pinot Noir give off lovely aromas of fresh strawberries, red currants, iron, black pepper and fresh flowers. Beautifully structured and lovely acidity leading into a long finish	3.00	12.00	55.00
<b>23. Teroldego – 2016, Ruth Lewandowski “Abandoned Meander”, Salt Lake City, UT</b> This swan song of a wine will never be made again. This silky wine greets you with notes of black fruit, and dusty tannins leading to a smooth finish so that you can enjoy it while it lasts.	3.00	14.00	70.00
<b>24. Carignan – 2017, Martha Stoumen, Mendocino County, CA</b> Dried tart cherry, berry jam, wet stone, orange peel and dusty tannins make up this wine with great acidity that will surprise your palate.	3.00	13.00	60.00
<b>25. Grenache – 2016, A Tribute to Grace, Santa Barbara County, CA</b> Cranberry, hibiscus and crushed gravel show on the nose, while the palate carries lively texture, persistent acidity and fresh flavors of pressed raspberries	3.00	13.00	60.00
<b>26. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2017, Fableist, Paso Robles, CA</b> Vibrant black currants, cedar and vanilla hit your tongue, as you’re warmed by the comforts of blackberries and cherries. A strong finish wraps you in a fond embrace	2.50	10.00	45.00
<b>27. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2016, Brea, Paso Robles, CA</b> 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Petite Verdot, 5% Merlot. The wine has bright red currant and berry fruit with a distinct mineral core wrapped in elegant tannins.	2.50	10.00	45.00
<b>28. Syrah – 2016, Cinder, Snake River Valley, ID</b> Allspice and black pepper notes in the nose develop into blackberries, dried orange peel and a hit of chai. The intensity of the bright fruit is mouthwatering.	2.75	11.00	50.00
<b>29. Merlot – 2016, Rutherford Ranch, Napa Valley, CA</b> Aromas of juicy blueberry, ripe Bing cherry and vanilla from oak aging compliment the luscious flavors. Enjoy the long, rich finish as the fruits dance on your tongue.	2.50	10.00	45.00
<b>30. Petite Sirah – 2012, Retro Cellars, Napa Valley, CA</b> Asian five-spice, strawberry and raspberry meld together seamlessly as a grip of tannin persists alongside notes of oak. Ripe and rich, it has a pretty nose of bay and mocha, finishing smoothly with subtle acidity.	3.00	13.00	60.00
<b>31. Syrah Red Blend – 2014, Marietta “Christo”, North Coast, CA</b> A blend of primarily Syrah, this wine also features Petite Sirah, Viognier, and Grenache. Full-bodied and fleshy, make it dark and brooding yet silky and smooth. Sage, tobacco, menthol and licorice round it out.	2.25	9.00	40.00
<b>32. Petite Sirah – 2013, Trinafour, Mendocino County, CA</b> Aromas are an energetic of black currant, blackberry, blueberry, violet, black fig, and tea. While sweet-savory notes of vanilla, baking-spice and sweet tobacco join the party. The finish is juicy and lingering.	2.75	11.00	50.00
<b>33. Zinfandel – 2014, Valravn, Sonoma County, CA</b> Layers of richness and complexity wrap around a core of wild strawberry and raspberry. Intoxicating aromatics with scents of mocha, espresso roast, violets and ripe red berries. Rich on the palate hints of licorice.	2.25	9.00	40.00
<b>34. Cabernet Franc – 2017, Habit, Santa Ynez Valley, CA</b> Bright berry flavors, earthy undertones, and a spicy finish make this wine a very silky and aromatic wine with a slight peppery finish that dances on the palate.	3.00	13.00	60.00
