An inviting splash of watermelon and strawberry notes, with bright and vibrant flavors of citrus and tropical fruit. Juicy!
- 18. Rosé – 2018 Cultivar, Napa Valley, CA – NEW!** 🌱
With notes of rich cranberries and citrus, this wine pairs perfectly with BBQ's, on the boat, beach, pool, or picnics.

- 23. Pinot Noir – 2018 Head High, Sonoma County, CA**
A delicious Pinot Noir with notes of red plums, and black cherries. The palate is juicy, and fruit forward followed by a round and lively mid palate full of smooth tannins.
- 24. Pinot Noir – 2016 Cedar + Salmon, Willamette Valley, OR – NEW!**
Brimming with fresh blackberry and plum aromas. This Pinot Noir gains earth and herb nuances with time. Ripe red plums and red cherries dominate the smooth palate, accent with a dash of herbs.
- 25. Pinot Noir – 2017 Lucienne ‘Smith Vineyard’, Santa Lucia Highlands, CA**
Aromas of stewed cherries, root beer, licorice, and fennel show on the nose of this single-vineyard bottling from the Hahn family. The palate is quite ripe with cherry and dried strawberry flavors, finishing with a prominent vanilla spice.
- 26. Merlot – 2015 Dreyer Family ‘Compass’ Wines, CA – NEW!** 🌱
Rich garnet color with aromas and taste of dark fruit of blueberries, black cherries, plums and figs finishing with a hint of chocolate. This wine shows depth, complexity, and structured tannins and rich texture. *And it's Vegan!*
- 27. Malbec – 2017 Black's Station, Yolo County, CA – NEW!**
Our 2017 Yolo County Malbec has pronounced aromas of saddle leather and mocha and big explosive flavors of blueberry, cranberry and boysenberry jam. A good grip of tannins balances the rich, dense weight of the wine. This is a substantial Malbec that is mouth-filling!
- 28. Red Blend – NV Locations Wines ‘TX7’, Lubbock, TX – Staff Favorite!**
This GSM blend also contains assorted Bordeaux varietals. Bursting with notes of juicy plum, cranberries, cherry cola, and baking spice, this wine has a smooth finish that commands attention to the Texas High Plains AVA.
- 29. Red Blend – 2017 Angels & Cowboys, Sonoma County, CA – Customer Favorite!**
This wine brings forth exquisite fruit from some of Sonoma County's most prestigious wine growers. A blend of Zinfandel, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, and Malbec that layers dark fruits and exotic spices to make this red delightful to drink.
- 30. Red Blend – 2017 Son of a Butcher, Napa Valley, CA – LIMITED TIME Everyone's Favorite!** 🌱
Bringing back this popular wine for just a limited time. Combining the new world fruitiness with old world earthiness, this rich wine carries notes of nutmeg and spice combined with dark fruits, such as blackberries. The perfect wine for any SOB!
- 31. Cabernet Franc – 2017 Michael David Winery ‘Inkblot’, Lodi, CA – NEW!**
Dark, decadent and alluring, this exudes aromas of black cherry, red plum, and baking spices. Heavy on the mouth with smooth, polished tannins, and flavors of strawberry jam, and dark chocolate with an ample finish.
- 32. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2017 ‘the girls in the vineyard’, Napa Valley, CA – LIMITED TIME** 🌱
Bringing back this popular easy drinking Cab for a limited time only! This medium bodied mountain Cabernet has flavors and aromas of ripe black cherry, dusty cocoa and plum. Its generous flavors are wrapped in a silky, fine texture and a long finish.
- 33. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2017 Christopher Michael, Columbia Valley, WA – Customer Favorite!** 🌱
A lighter body Cabernet Sauvignon, that is fruit forward with notes of chocolate, black cherry, cassis, cigar box, and vanilla. It's an easy drinking wine at an amazing price point! Washington wine region is impressing us!
- 34. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2017 Silver Ghost, Napa Valley, CA – Customer Favorite!** 🌱
Full bodied with aromas of black cherry, blueberry, and cassis. The palate reveals layers of red and black fruit intermingled with mocha, savory spice and toast providing a rich texture and depth in the long finish.
- 35. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2014 Wolf's Head, Napa Valley, CA**
The initial pour exhibits aromas of fresh leather, earthy minerals, and dusty graphite. A little time in the glass evolves into sweet dark cherries, blackberries, and cassis with hints of tobacco and a long finish leaving one wanting more. Wine Spectrum 94 pts
- 36. Zinfandel – 2016 Badgerhound, Sonoma County, CA – Customer Favorite!**
Appealing aromas of crushed raspberries and blackberries are framed by vanilla and cigar box notes. This wine shows sweet concentrated fruit in the mouth with plenty of oak, tannins and acidity to balance the ripeness. The finish is long, rich & intense.
