<b>19. Pinot Noir – 2019 Sieur D’Arques ‘Cuvee Lacustre’, Pays d’Oc, France</b> This 100% Pinot Noir is light, balanced, and well-structured with melted tannins, red fruit flavors of strawberry, cherry, and raspberry and a subtle spicy note on the finish.	2.75	11.00	34.00
<b>20. Pinot Noir – 2021 Oak Valley Estate ‘Sounds of Silence’, Elgin, South Africa</b> A delicate Pinot Noir with aromas of dried florals and an inviting earthiness. The palate is fresh and juicy with prominent flavors of cherry, cranberry, and strawberry with a long and crunchy finish!	3.50	14.00	40.00
<b>21. Pinot Noir – 2016 Brave Cellars ‘Less Traveled’, Willamette Valley, OR</b> An elegant expression of silky Pinot Noir with notes of bright red cherry, raspberry and pomegranate and herbs with a touch of baking spices lingering through the finish.	 3.50	14.00	40.00

<b>32. Red Blend – 2018 ‘Hidden Asset’, Santa Barbara, CA</b> Earthy, leathery, and wet oak aromas are enticing. <b>33. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2020 ‘Into the Woods’, Columbia Valley, WA</b> A full-bodied wine, with pronounced elegant flavors of dark blackberry compote, fresh-picked blue plum, and subtle essence of orange zest providing bold flavors and perfect balance. <b>34. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2018 689 Cellars ‘Lucky Draw’, Various Counties, CA</b> This classic full-bodied Cabernet riffs on old school structure and tannins while highlighting blueberry, dark cherry, and cocoa notes. <b>37. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2017 Hoopes, Oakville, CA – NEW!</b> Aromas of plum and cherry lead to a vibrant and full palate of ripe fig, cocoa, and leather notes on top of soft silky tannins.
