I. Sparkling Brut - J Cuvee 20 NV, Russian River Valley Loaded with notes of stone fruit, brioche, and crisp green apple. 49% Chardonnay, 49% Pinot Noir, 2% Pinot Meunier.	3.00	12.00	35.00
2. Trousseau Gris - 2012 Falcor, Russian River Valley Notes of green melon, peach, and tropical fruit give way to a soft palate with minerality on the finish. This obscure varietal is only grown in one vineyard in California and Falcor is one of only a few wineries to use this fruit.	3.00	12.00	35.00
3. Pinot Grigio - 2011 Montevolpe, Mendocino County Floral and citrus aromas give way to flavors of white peaches and nectarine on the palate. Refreshing acid on the finish makes this wine great for everyday drinking or a perfect pairing with grilled seafood and salads.	2.25	7.00	26.00
4. 8. Rosé - 2012 Blackbird, Napa Valley 38% Merlot, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 26% Cabernet Franc make up this Bordeaux inspired Rose sourced from several premiere vineyards in Napa. Notes of bright strawberry lead to citrus and a refreshing minerality on the palate.	3.25	13.00	37.00
5. Chardonnay - 2011 Lost Canyon, Russian River Valley A beautiful single vineyard Chardonnay from the Ruxton Vineyard planted in 1977. This wine starts off with notes of lemon and creme brûlée leading to a buttery, oaky finish with hints of citrus. Less than 550 cases produced.	3.75	15.00	41.00
6. Riesling - 2010 Santa Barbara Winery, Santa Rita Hills Ripe fruit aromas of apricots and notes of jasmine. Off-dry in style with initial sweetness on the palate, a nectar-like mouth feel, nice minerality, balancing out with nice acid.	2.75	11.00	32.00
7. Late Harvest Viognier - 2009 Westerly, Happy Canyon, Santa Barbara Sweet aromas of honeysuckle, peaches, and pears. Flavors of peach cobbler, honey and golden raisins with a lemon meringue finish. Dessert in a glass! 375 ml.	4.00 1 oz	12.00 3 oz	38.00
Wines are listed from lightest to fullest. 8. Pinot Noir - 2011 Bluxome Street, Russian River Valley Made using 100% native yeast, this wine starts off with cherry, rose water, and cola notes. Fruit forward but with well integrated acidity.	3.50	14.00	39.00
9. Barbera - 2010 Pianetta, Central Coast Soft nose of rose petals with mild berry and spice. Flavors of light cherry, plum, and toasty oak notes, ending in a silky mouth feel.	4.00	16.00	45.00
10. Malbec - 2010 Rancho Sisquoc, Santa Barbara County A great Malbec that deftly splits the difference between the French and Argentinian styles. Loads of purple fruit, balanced acidity, subtle earthiness, and a kiss of oak. Under 500 cases made.	3.25	13.00	37.00
I I. Tempranillo (10% Cabernet) - 2007 Bodegas, "Viva Yo!" Paso Robles Fantastic aromas of plum, black cherry, coffee and hint of chocolate. Aged 24 months in oak, with good tannins and structure.	3.00	12.00	35.00
12. Cabernet Sauvignon Blend - 2011 Broadside, San Luis Obispo 70% Cabernet Sauvignon and 30% Merlot, this blend is sourced from the same vineyards that acclaimed winery Justin uses for their Isosceles blend. Aged in 100% neutral French oak and fermented entirely with native yeast.	3.25	13.00	37.00
13. Sangiovese Blend - 2010 Rancho Sisquoc "Tre Vini," Santa Barbara County Composed of 55% Sangiovese, 25% Syrah, and 20% Malbec, this blend offers up dark cherry and cranberry notes rounded out by leather and an earthy spice.	3.25	13.00	37.00
14. Zinfandel - 2011 Kokomo, Dry Creek Valley In this blend of Zinfandel from three Dry Creek Valley vineyards, juicy black fruit flavors are perfectly balanced with acidity and an earthy spice. Only 300 cases produced.	3.75	15.00	42.00
15. Red Field Blend - 2008 Hendry, Napa Valley This Petit Verdot based blend shows subtle aromas of blackberry, cocoa, eucalyptus, and mint. Flavors of deep blackberry and bittersweet chocolate finish with firm tannins.	5.25	21.00	56.00
